

# 2023 Deadlines & Reminders

## Harvested Production Reports

MASC requires that all insured producers file a Harvested Production Report (HPR) that details the production of all crops grown on their declared acreages. HPRs can be filed online through *myMASC*, by email, or by faxing or visiting an MASC Service Centre. HPRs for the 2023 crop year must be submitted to MASC by **November 30, 2023**

to avoid a **\$500** late filing fee. Several resources are available to help you file your HPR at

## Claim Notification Deadline for Greenfeed & Forages

The deadline for registering a greenfeed or forage claim, without a late fee, is **October 1** (October 3 for 2023). A claim must be registered with MASC 10 days prior to any production being used for feed. The final deadline for registering a claim is **November 30**. Claims filed after October 1 (October 3 for 2023), but before November 30, are subject to a late fee of 25 per cent of the indemnity (maximum \$1,000).

## Winter Wheat & Fall Rye Seeding Deadlines

The full coverage seeding deadline for **winter wheat** and **fall rye** is from **August 15** to **September 25** for full coverage, and **September 26** to **September 30** for reduced coverage.

## 2023 Excess Moisture Insurance

The deadline for making changes to the Excess Moisture Insurance (EMI) Reduced Deductible Option and the EMI Higher Dollar Value Option is **November 30, 2023**. Land must be added to your AgriInsurance contract by **March 31, 2024**, for those acres to be eligible for EMI coverage in that year. Land added after March 31 will continue to be eligible for coverage for seeded crops and hail, but not for EMI.

## Wildlife Damage

The Wildlife Damage Compensation program covers crop damage caused by deer, elk, moose, bear, wood bison, ducks, geese, or sandhill cranes. Report losses as soon as possible, so arrangements can be made for an adjustor's appraisal. The crop cannot be adjusted if it has already been harvested.

## Online Services - *myMASC*

MASC's client access portal for online services, *myMASC*, allows you to sign up to receive your insurance payment by direct deposit, apply for or register a claim for Hail Insurance, and complete your **Harvested Production Report**, all from the convenience of your home. You can also check the status of a claim through *myMASC*, as well as obtain copies of your Statement of Account and review your crop management history. Call an MASC Service Centre to set up your *myMASC* account.
