

HAIL INSURANCE APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Most acres of an insurable crop are eligible for hail and fire coverage regardless of the variety grown or the seeding date, provided you have an AgrilInsurance contract.

The circled numbers on the Hail Insurance application example on page 2 correspond to the following numbers. Please follow these instructions and the example when completing your Hail Insurance application.

- 1) Enter only one dollar selection for each crop that you are insuring, regardless of whether crop shares are involved.
- 2) The legal description and risk area that you farm is indicated. Add any new legal descriptions.
- 3) Enter the crop and the number of acres for each legal description that you are insuring. If you do not list a crop opposite a specific legal description, you will not have Hail Insurance for the crop on that legal description. Ensure that the crop and number of acres are identical on your Hail Insurance application and Seeded Acreage Report.
- 4) If you are selecting Hail Insurance on forages:
 - For forage insured under the Basic Hay Insurance program, you may only choose one coverage level that will apply to all acres selected for Hail Insurance.
 - For uninsured forage and acres insured under the Select Hay Insurance program, you may choose a different dollar selection for each forage type.
- 5) The premium per acre and the dollar selections available for each of the insurable crops are listed by risk area on page four of this package. Please be careful to select the appropriate premium considering the risk area where the crop is grown and the dollar selection. **If there are any discrepancies, we will adjust your premium based on the dollar selection that you have indicated for the crop.** Premiums will vary by crop, dollar selection and risk area.
- 6) The “share” column pertains to any land you currently have listed under your AgrilInsurance contract as being farmed on a crop share basis with another insured. Use the share amount to calculate your premium for that crop and legal description (step 7).
- 7) To determine the premium amount, multiply the number of acres (step 3) by the premium per acre (step 5), and then by your share (step 6).
- 8) Add up all the premium amounts and record the total in the “Total Premium” box.
- 9) If you are paying the premium with your application, deduct five per cent of the amount being paid. If you are not paying premium with your application, leave this space blank.
- 10) The Amount Enclosed is the amount of payment that is submitted with the application. A cheque or money order for this amount payable to MASC should be included.
- 11) Indicate if any of the crops selected for Hail Insurance have been damaged by hail or fire this crop year.
- 12) Read the declaration carefully and sign the application. If you are signing as an agent of the applicant, you must also print your name.

If you wish to appoint an alternate signing authority other than the person(s) currently listed for your AgrilInsurance contract, contact MASC. Refer to Term # 4 and Term # 5, as applicable, on the reverse of the Hail Insurance application.

Check your application carefully. Applications can be sent by mail, delivered in person, sent by fax, completed online, or made over the telephone by contacting MASC during normal business hours. **Please do not use the MASC drop off box for Hail Insurance applications.**

A Statement of Hail Insurance summarizing your selections and premiums will be mailed to you. Please check it carefully. If the calculated amount of premium does not coincide with the dollar amount per acre that you selected for a crop, MASC will base your insurance on the dollar selection indicated and will adjust your calculated premium amount accordingly.

If the person signing the application is different from the applicant, then by signing the application that person is representing that they have the authority to bind the applicant. In the absence of such authority, the person signing is personally liable for all amounts due and payable to MASC. If the applicant is a corporation, the person signing the application on behalf of the corporation is jointly and severally liable with the applicant for all amounts due and payable to MASC.

If you wish to take additional coverage at a later date, contact MASC.

Note 1: Prior to July 30, part or all of your hail insurance coverage may be cancelled by the applicant by sending a request for cancellation in writing. A percentage of the premium will be refunded based on a short date cancellation table.

Note 2: Under the Continuous Hail Insurance Option, coverage can only be cancelled if acres have been appraised by MASC and destroyed.
